What is a SENDIAS service?

A SENDIASS gives support and advice to parents and carers whose children fall into the government's special educational needs and disability (SEND) category.



KIDS WISA is the SENDIAS service for Wiltshire and we can offer free, independent and neutral information on special educational needs and can give guidance to help young people with SEND and their parent/carers to make appropriate, informed choices relating to education, health and social care.

Views & Concerns

We support families and young people in understanding SEN Support and applying for Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCPs), as well as support for an Annual Review.

Mediation & Tribunals

We can support you to get to grips with the appeals process, prepare for mediation or tribunal and can accompany you to meetings.
